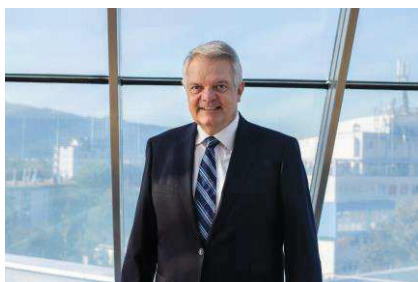
Johan Lindström; Plåt & Ventföretagen, Sweden
